

Condition of the Planets

First we evaluate the positive or negative condition of each planet, using two criteria: dignity and house placement. Dignity ranges from exaltation to debilitation, scored 100 ~ 0. House placement scores 100 for any trine or angle, 75 for the 2nd or 11th house, 50 for the 3rd, 0 for the 6th, 8th or 12th.

Influence of Benefics and Malefics

Next, we calculate the amount of influence (via aspect or conjunction) that benefics (Jupiter and Venus) and malefics (Mars and Saturn) have on the cusp of each house. The previously calculated amount of negativity in a benefic's condition removes up to half its positive effect, while the amount of positivity in a malefic's condition removes up to half its negative effect. Adding the values thus summed for Jupiter and Venus describes the amount of positive influence on a house. Adding them for Mars and Saturn describes the amount of negative influence.

Influence of the House Lord

Now we calculate the amount of influence a house's lord has on it. But, a lord's lack of dignity can remove up to half its positive effect.

Final Tally

For the positive tally, add the influence of benefics to the influence of the house lord and divide by 2. For the negative tally, subtract the influence of the house lord from the influence of malefics. For houses 6, 8, and 12 invert the values of the lord's house, so that it is most advantageous for them to occupy 6, 8, and 12, and most disadvantageous for them to occupy the angles and trines. Also invert the effects of benefics and malefics for these houses, so that it is advantageous for them to be affected by malefics.
